Okay, we promised we'd do it straight in this flyer. Three Rivers Decennial Birthday Bash will be Saturday, June 29, A.S. XX, at a new (to you) site called Fontbonne College. The day will offer a variety of martial and non-martial pursuits; Shakespeare and an auction will close the day; and feasting and court will fill the evening.

For the fighting, we've borrowed an idea called a Challenge Tourney (with thanks to Sir Andrew Lyon of Wolvenwood) that goes like this. It's all challenges, and the winner of each fight racks up points according to the caliber of the defeated opponent: 5 points for a Royal Peer by right of arms, 4 for Chivalry, 3 for Huscarls, 2 for Fyrdmen, and 1 for none of the above. (No, it's not cumulative; if your victim is Graf Sir Shadan, you only get 5 points, not 15.) A similar point scale exists for non-Calontir fighters; and there will be a rest area where tired fighters can be safe from further challenges. Highest point total wins.

For the less martial among you, dancing and dance instruction will be available, and a shady corner will be set aside for tall tales and other bragging. An unofficial juggling get-together may well occur, possibly including teaching (learn to play with your balls from some of Calontir's most experienced!) and maybe an unofficial contest. Lunch will be available from House Falconsnest, for a price.

Later in the afternoon, Lady Swietoslawa Jolanta Leszczynska, our Chatelaine, will be auctioning off all the accumulated lost and found of ten years of history. If you think some of it may be yours, seek her out and claim your stuff BEFORE the auction! (Rumor mentions special bonuses to anyone who can pronounce her name correctly.) This will be followed by a production of Shakespeare's The Taming of the Shrew, directed by Lady Gerddny Gunnarsdottir.

As the evening wears on, we will have a semi-potluck feast: the Barony will provide barbecued roast beef, lemonade and tea, and Strawberry Fool, and anyone who wants in should bring a contribution according to this scheme: If the first initial of your SCA first name is A through D, bring fruits or veggies; E-L, cheese; M-S, breads; and T-Z, butter (herb, honey, etc.) or other dips. For people like me who don't plan ahead well, there is a supermarket nearby. The feast, unfortunately, is limited to the first 150 paid reservations, and there is no off-board seating; get 'em in now! For further entertainment and hilarity, an original song contest will be judged at the feast; songs should deal with the early history and/or people of Three Rivers.

Let me see; what else does the honorable Lady Jayce Ravenhair want in a flyer? Troll booth Friday night will be at Baroness Genevieve and Lord Ali's; see below. The schedule will be like this: site opens 8:30, waivers and inspection at 9:00, fighting starts at 10:00, dancing, tall tales, and juggling start whenever they start, lunch at lunchtime, fighting stops at 4:00, auction at 4:00, the play starts at 4:30, feast at 7:00, court(s) (Baronial and maybe Royal) after feast, and site closes at 11:00. Showers will be available.

The price for this marvel is: \$2.50 site fee; \$1.50 more for the feast (plus your potluck contribution); paid reservations only; checks made out to SCA Inc; site is discreetly wet (beer, wine, mead only, and only in period containers); that's all.

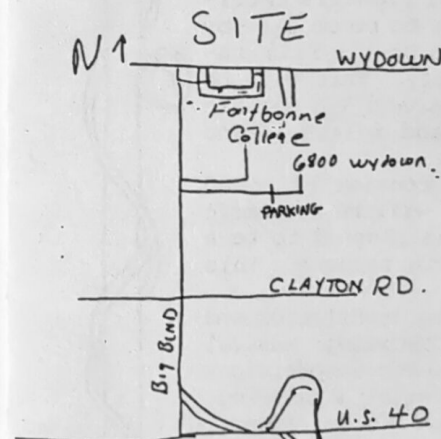

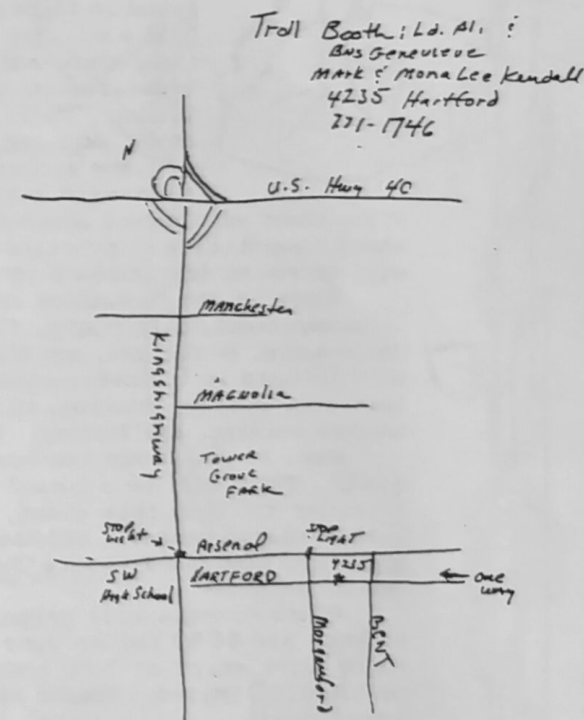

The good gentles of the Kingdom of Calontir are welcomed to the Festival of Sprites hosted by the Barony of Forgotten Sea.

Time is drawing near for all to be sharpening swords, stringing bows, bringing out your best art and/or science, learning rhyme-scheme of Shakespearian sonnets, cleaning your feast dishes, setting up your tent, and of course, warming up your wings for an eventful day at Sprites.

Starting off the day we ask all fighters interested in fighting in the tournament to be on site by 9:30 a.m.. The tournament will be a Double Elimination, three-man team Bush-kazi tourney. This will be organized by Ld. Halidar Arkellas and Ld. Dobbin Viidor. There will be challenges and melees if you aren't worn out from the Tourney.

The Archery Competition will consist of speed shooting at various distances. This will be a Pennsic style shoot with points awarded accordingly. This is planned to be a short competition so practice and qualifications can be done. This will be run by Herr Richard von Kassovo.

Enter in the Pentathlon in the Arts of: Cooking (subtleties and illusion foods), Calligraphy, Illumination, Poetry, Costuming, Musical Performance, Needlework, and Drawing & Painting. Science competitions will be held in the categories of Wood working, Vinting & Brewing, Spinning, Dyeing, Weaving, Metal working (non-armor + non-weapon), Leather working, and Pottery. These will be judged by Kingdom rules.

Now, if you're not too busy, how would you like to join in on a quest? There will be a buried Treasure Chest to be found and dug up. In order to find this chest, you must know the rhyme scheme of Shakespearian sonnets, and have pen and paper. Seven teams will be needed to find the Treasure Chest. More information will be handed out on the site.

House Kinross will prepare the feast for the evening. Feast tickets are \$6.50 before June 8th, then will go up to \$7.50. The Feast will start at 7:00 p.m. sharp! Send reservations early as seating is limited. Please send any food allergy information with reservations.

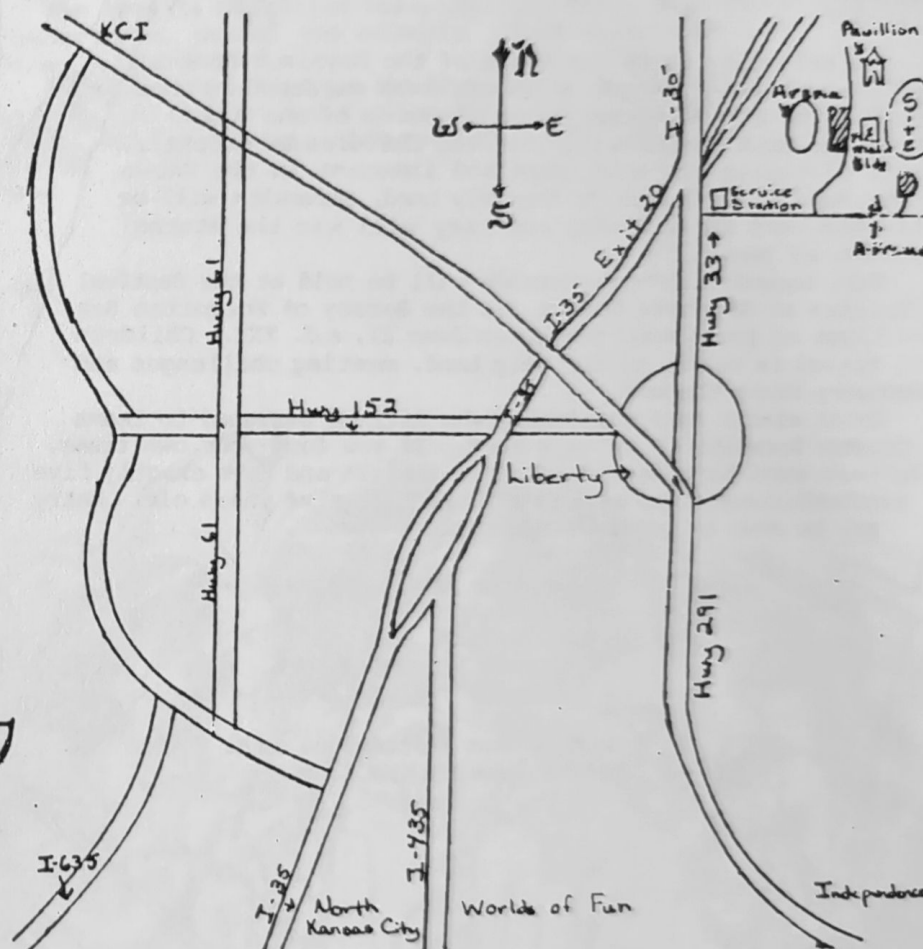
After the feast will be the traditional Sprites costume contest. Wear your best Spritely garb!
