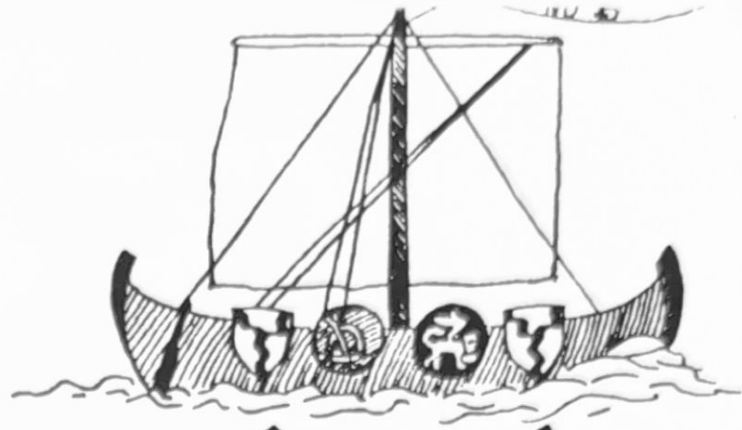

Discovery Event et Highland Games

Come to the beautiful Shire of Bois d'Arc for the Discovery Event on Saturday and Sunday, October 19 and 20, A.S. XX (1985). This is a relaxed time of competitions and good companionship. Site is a public campsite nestled amongst the changing colors of autumn at the Elk City Reservoir, northeast of Independence, Kansas.

Munchkins are very welcome. This is a safe site with room to run except for one consideration. The spillway is located a short distance from the camping. Small ones should be watched.

The Site is Very Wet. Let's keep it period, though by using tankards in place of cans. There is a site fee of \$3.00 per gentle. Picnic tables, grills, and bonfire rings are scattered throughout the site for your use. Showers are nearby. So far, the groundskeepers are very pleased with us. We want to keep in their good graces.

The Feast is semi-potluck. We will provide thick meat stew and bread. Everyone who wants to feast should bring a contribution according to their SCA first names:

S - Z: Desert, honey, butter or similar and potables

Bring rugs, pillows, and lights for feasting on the ground.

WORKSHOPS: Ladies and Lords, for the first time Discovery features two workshops for elimination of "Isn't there anything I can do?" Workshops will be held on Herbalism and Weaving, with hands-on lessons - watch cloth evolve before your very eyes.

The planned Arts and Science Competitions include: Needlework of all kinds; plain and patterned weaving; costume accessories; cartography; calligraphy and illumination; herbalism; armour and weapons; leather work; and plenty of brewing (we hope). There is to be a special tall tales competition for the enjoyment of the populace and our Scottish seneschal.

HIGHLAND GAMES: We are proud that Lord William Blackfox of Northkeep has consented to honor us again this year by conducting our special feature - the Highland Games, including discus and hammer throwing.

A swimming beach is available at no charge. Fishing is allowed on the site.

From Their Royal Majesties

Fair Greetings,

We would like to take this opportunity to publish some of the important news generated at coronation.

The Fall Crown tournament will be held November 9, A.S. XX (1985ce) in the Shire of Spinning Winds. This will be an open list to all authorized fighters, subject to the requirements set down in the Corpora and Kingdom law. Those individuals wishing to enter this list, must send Us a letter stating their intent to seek the Crown. In addition to this letter, they must also send us their and their consort's proof of membership (a photocopy of membership card or mailing label), and their and their consort's proof of age of majority (a photocopy of drivers license or birth certificate). This information must reach us on or before October 31, A.S. XX (1985ce). Entrants into the list are strongly urged to introduce their prospective consorts to Her Majesty, at an event between now and Crown Tournament. Entrants into the Crown list must meet these requirements, there will be no exceptions.

Effective October 15, A.S. XX (1985ce) all individuals attending official SCA events must sign one of the waiver forms, and must carry their copy on their person at all times while at the event. This includes while fighting! Individuals who do not have a waiver on their person, will be asked to leave the site of the event.

Those groups wishing to host the Spring Coronation, should submit bids to Us in writing, at or before Crown Tournament. Please plan ahead so that We and Our successors can announce a coronation date as soon as possible. Coronation should fall in the month of March.

The following edicts were announced at Coronation:

For the duration of Our reign, subjects of Our realm need not relieve themselves of their weaponry in Our presence.

For the duration of Our reign, Pepsi is the one "True" cola.

The following edicts were announced at the Wedding Event in Mag Mor:

For the duration of Our reign, mirrored sunglasses are period.

For the duration of Our reign, children of the Crown of Calontir, may be addressed as Prince/Princess Royale, or as Prince/Princess Dumnonia.
