## Information on Upcoming Events

Valor Tourney September 3-5, 1988 V'tavia (Witchita, KS)

Lots of fighting! A boar hunt on Saturday morning, with a living chess tournament that afternoon. The Valor and Guardians of Valor Tournies will be held on Sunday, and the Fyrdmen vs. Men-at-Arms tourney will be held on Monday. There will be an extensive A&S competition, with special prizes for Calligraphy and Illumination, Costume Design, Costuming, Non-Cross Stitch Needlework, Armoring, Brewing, Leatherwork, Weaving, and Woodworking. Autumn Event September 10, 1988 Elkshire (Norfolk, NE)

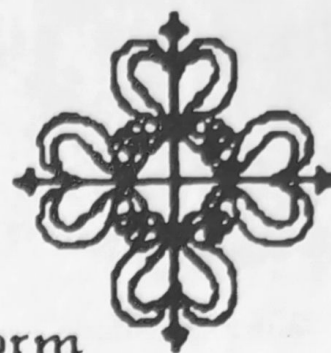
