

Stoutheart Tourney, April 28, Coeur d'Ennu Des Moines


There will be a Celtic Maiden tourney, a two person tourney with one member of each sex, and various contest and competitions. Please see the MEWS for more details.


Lilies IV, May 30 - June 3 Forgotten Sea Odessa, MO
