

DOOM AND CHILL DREAD SHOSHANA BAS NACHMAN

Doom and chill dread: Returns the Cold Drake. His bitter-most breath burns what small tilth, What aught in the earth the autumn hath left. Will famine or food be left for the folk?

Chill is the breath that blows from the beast. For babes and the eld, the bite is most bitter. Svalr the Iss-wyrm savors the sundry Death and deep dark adrift in the land.

Drawn by the need, newly anointed,
Thick in thew, Thane of the Sun
Rodhul-nidhr Bright-helm arrives in the realm,
His long ash aligned on limb of the beast.

Iss-wyrm the Ancient blows frigid air Hoping to hinder the spear and the helm. Geisl-ash glimmers, aglint in the light. Strikes Sunna-sonr! Sore in the vitals Of Ice-bringer Svalr lies iron and ash.

Summer-thane strides thence in success.

The folk will live fair and fortune return.

But the wyrm is but wounded. The world is yet his.

Norse themes bent to a seasonal metaphor; this piece is done in the style of 9th-C. Beowulf (Old English), alliterative verse: Each line contains a natural pause between half-lines. Each half-line contains two strong beats (and any number of weak beats); among the four strong beats, three must alliterate: They share the same initial consonant sound (with any initial vowel-sound counted as the empty consonant). (I broke strict Germanic alliterative rules by alliterating /st/ with /s/ in the last stanza.)
